

Launched on August 2002

Based on Brazilian Standards (ABNT)

Certification / Labelling by third parties (accredited by Inmetro)





CERFLOR

Principles:

- Responsibility in the short, medium and long-term use of forest resources in order to promote its sustainability
- Care for biological diversity
- Care for water, soil and air resources
- Environmental, economic and social development of the regions where forest activities are being conducted

Next November: peaches

Next December: bananas

- Commitment to updated technology




PBE - Labelling Scheme related to efficiency of energy consuming products
